## Ways to deposit money to an offender account:

1. ONLINE: at [www.forecommsolutions.com](http://www.forecommsolutions.com) by using a credit or debit card. (Processing/service charges do apply based on amount of deposit.)
2. KIOSK: when family/friends visit, they can use the lobby kiosk to deposit cash or use a debit/credit card.
3. U.S. POSTAL SERVICE MONEY ORDERS: Tangipahoa Parish Jail **WILL NOT** process money orders. All money orders mailed to our facility and not filled out as directed below **WILL BE DESTROYED.**

The money order **MUST** be payable to “**Inmate Account Management Fund.**” Offender name and resident ID number must be printed on the money order. The sender’s contact information **MUST** be completed in full. (There will be a \$1.00 processing charge deducted from the amount set.)
